

# High Power Rules

## Sign-up for Relays

- The range fee is \$5 for members, and \$10 for non-members.
- Your shooting position is determined by the sign-up sheet, not by having equipment on the shooting line.
- 8:45am - sign-up deadline, for the first relay
- 9:00am - first relay will begin
- 10:15am – sign-up deadline for the second relay
- 10:30am - second relay will begin

## Equipment Required For Match

- Shooting glasses & hearing protection
- Slings allowed
- Shooting mats allowed
- Spotting scopes allowed
- Shooting coats allowed
- Shooting gloves allowed

## Equipment Not Allowed

- No telescopic / optical sights allowed
- No full / select fire automatic weapons allowed

## Ammo Required

- 60 rounds (10 for sighters, 50 for score)

## Targets

- Targets will be hung by shooter
- Shooter will supply target pasters
- SR target is used for Sighters, Offhand & Sitting Rapid Fire
- SR-42 target is used for Prone Rapid Fire
- MR-52 target is used for Prone Slow Fire

## Course of Fire

- Stage 1 – 10 minute sight-in period
- Stage 2 – Offhand
  - 3 minute prep period
  - Start in standing position
  - Single fire 10 rounds at 200 yard target
  - No sling allowed

- 10 minute time limit
- Stage 3 – Sitting Rapid
  - 3 minute prep period
  - Start in standing position
  - 2 or 5 rounds can be loaded initially
  - Drop to sitting position, fire 10 rounds at 200 yard target
  - One reload is required
  - Sling is permitted
  - 60 second time limit
- Stage 4 – Prone Rapid
  - 3 minute prep period
  - Start in standing position
  - 2 or 5 rounds can be loaded initially
  - Drop to prone position, fire 10 rounds at 200 yard target
  - One reload is required
  - Sling is permitted
  - 70 second time limit
- Stage 5 – Prone Slow
  - 3 minute prep period
  - Start in Prone position
  - Single fire 20 rounds at 200 yard target
  - Sling is permitted
  - 20 minute time limit

### **Scoring**

- Scoring values are determined by the point value on the targets. 500-50X is maximum score possible.
- Scoring will be by NRA rules & classifications.

### **Other Rules**

- Obey all Range Officer commands.
- Pay attention, and be safety conscious.
- Indoor and Outdoor ranges are closed during High Power match.
- To qualify for awards, you must shoot in at least 7 of 12 matches in your classification.
- Unused target frames are the responsibility of the shooter, to return to the storage shed.
- Make-up matches are allowed. No shooting ahead.
- Please keep pets off of grounds. They distract shooters.
- Shooters are responsible for clean-up.
- Awards are awarded to members only, and will be presented at the annual banquet.
