

Hunting Rifle Match @ MRPC

Objective:

To improve snap shooting skills, which may be encountered while hunting the Michigan Whitetail Deer.

Targets:

9 inch white paper plate, at 50, 100, & 200 yards

Firearms Allowed:

Any centerfire rifle allowed under Michigan DNR hunting regulations. The exception is any Match rifles, or DCM/CMP Service Rifles (i.e. M1, M1A, AR-15, etc.). The object is to use only standard hunting rifles.

Scoped Rifles OK & Semi-auto OK (i.e. Remington 742, etc.)

Ammo:

This course requires 3 rounds shot at 50 yards, 4 shots at 100 yards, & 5 shots at 200 Yards. Total of 12 rounds used

Starting Position:

High Ready / Port Arms – This position is the buttstock at the belt line, & the muzzle at or above the shoulder.

Slings can be used, but must be unslung until AFTER the start signal.

Course Of Fire:

The participant starts standing in High Ready. For each string of fire, the timer gives a signal (whistle) & starts the clock. At the signal, the participant assumes any shooting position and fires one shot at the target. Time stops when the participant fires their one shot. Record the elapsed time to the nearest tenth of a second (0.1 second) & repeat for each shot.

Stage One: 50 yards. 3 shots

Stage Two: 100 yards. 4 shots

Stage Three: 200 yards. 5 shots

Scoring:

After the participant has completed all 12 shots & the elapsed times are recorded, clear the range & score the targets. The targets are scored as a hit or a miss. Add a ten second penalty for each missed shot. The score for each stage is elapsed time for each shot, plus any penalties. Obviously, a lower time is a better score.

Examples:

Participant A posts times of 2.2, 2.5, & 2.1 on Stage 1. The 50 yard target has three bullet holes, so their Stage 1 score is 6.8 ($2.2 + 2.5 + 2.1$).

Participant B posts times of 3.4, 3.6, 4.9, and 5.0 on Stage 2. The 100 yard target has two only bullet holes, so their score is 36.9 ($3.4 + 3.6 + 4.9 + 5.0 + 10 + 10$).

- NO shooting rests / shooting sticks / bipods / artificial rests
